Class 1: Newcomers 3 phase. Short POR followed by COP and PTV phases. **Combination of horse and rider** not to have been placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in two or more Newcomer classes, or one intermediate or one open class at indoor/arena TREC competitions prior to 1st October 2014.

Class 2a: Unaffiliated Newcomers. COP and PTV phases only. Restrictions as per class 1.

Class 2b: Affiliated Newcomers TREC GB RS-tor Rider Safety Aid Class. COP and PTV phases only. Restrictions as per class 1.

Class 3: Intermediate 3 phase. Short POR followed by COP and PTV phases. **Combination of horse and rider** not to have been placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in two or more Intermediate classes, or one open class at Indoor/arena TREC competitions prior to 1<sup>st</sup> October 2014

Class 4a: Unaffiliated Intermediate: Cop and PTV phases only. Restrictions as per class 3.

Class 4b: Affiliated Intermediate TREC GB RS-tor Rider Safety Aid Class. COP and PTV phases only. Restrictions as per Class 3.

Class 5: Unaffiliated Open 3 phase. Short POR followed by Cop and PTV phases. Open to all.

Class 6a: Unaffiliated Open. COP and PTV phases only. Open to all.

Class 6b: Affiliated Open TREC GB RS-tor Rider Safety Aid Class. COP and PTV phases only. Open to all.

Class 7: Unaffiliated Pairs. This is a fun class. One rider will do the COP and the other the PTV. You may share a horse/pony or ride one each. If you do not have a pair, let us know and we will try to find one for you. Open to all.

Entry fees: Classes 1,3,5	£25.00
Classes 2a,4a,6a	£12.00 for one round, £20 for two rounds and £25 for three rounds
Classes 2b, 4b,6b	£15.00 for one round, £25 for two rounds and £32 for 3 rounds (£2.00 for each round goes to TREC GB)
Class 7	£10 per pair

Hard hats of current UK safety standards must be worn and correctly fastened at all times when mounted and it is also highly recommended that they be worn and fastened when working with horses from the ground.  
Back protectors are recommended for jumping.  
The judges decision is final. Any objections should be made in writing within 10 mins of the results being posted.  
If your horse/pony is showing any signs of an infectious or contagious disease, or is coming from a yard or area where either is known or suspected, please use common sense and stay away.  
No dogs allowed.  
Smoking is not permitted anywhere on the premises.  
No mucking out of boxes or trailers in the yard Any hay left in the yard must be cleared away.  
When you enter for any of the classes it is deemed that you have read, understood and will abide by the rules
